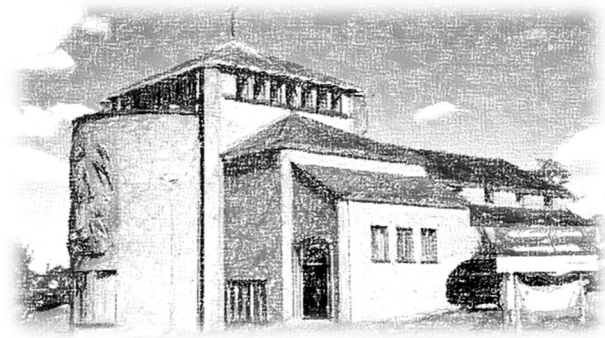
Enquirers and Seekers Group
